DISSEMINATION OPTIONS

ATTENTION: The description of your thesis will be available online whichever dissemination option you may chose. Titles, keywords and abstracts will be visible.



Immediate Dissemination

The thesis will be available to everyone online as soon as the library validates your final deposit, after the defense.



Embargo (up to 5 years)

If your thesis contains data still to be exploited or submitted, accepted, or recently published papers, you may want to postpone its online availability.

During the embargo, the thesis is only available within Paris-Saclay libraries and on theses.fr, upon authentication, for members of the French academic community.

The thesis will be available online, in open access, as soon as the embargo is lifted.

Confidentiality (in case of patent application or sensitive data)

The thesis will not be available at everyone during the confidentiality period. Once this period comes to an end, the thesis will be available online immediately or following an additional embargo period.

Please contact your doctoral school and start the confidentiality application process **at least 3 months before the defense**. This request should be submitted to and approved by the President of the University.
